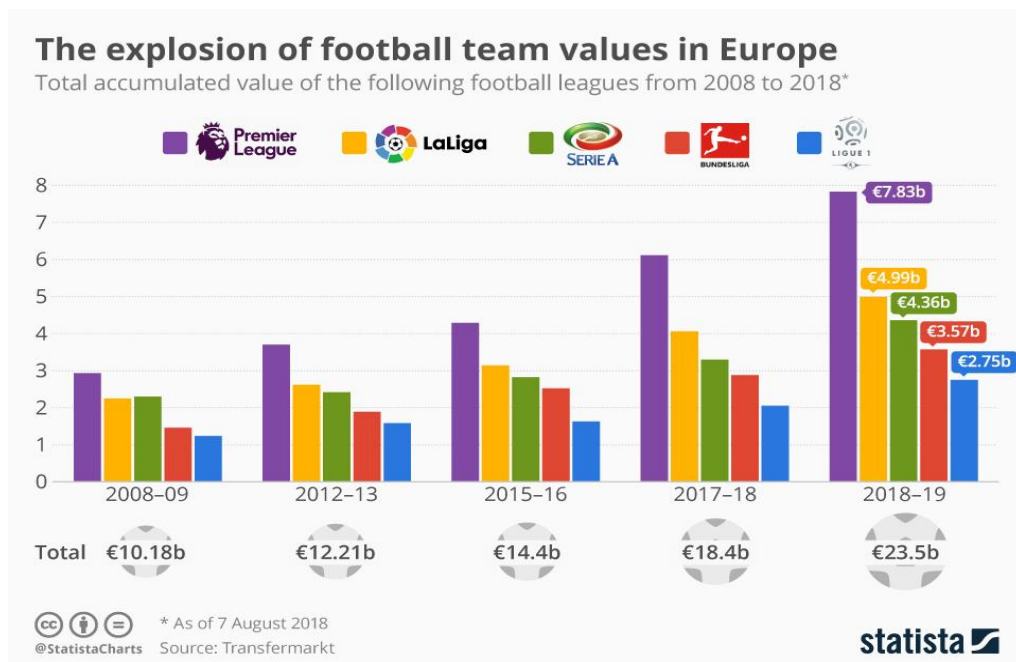


Figure 1: Revenue earned by each big European league

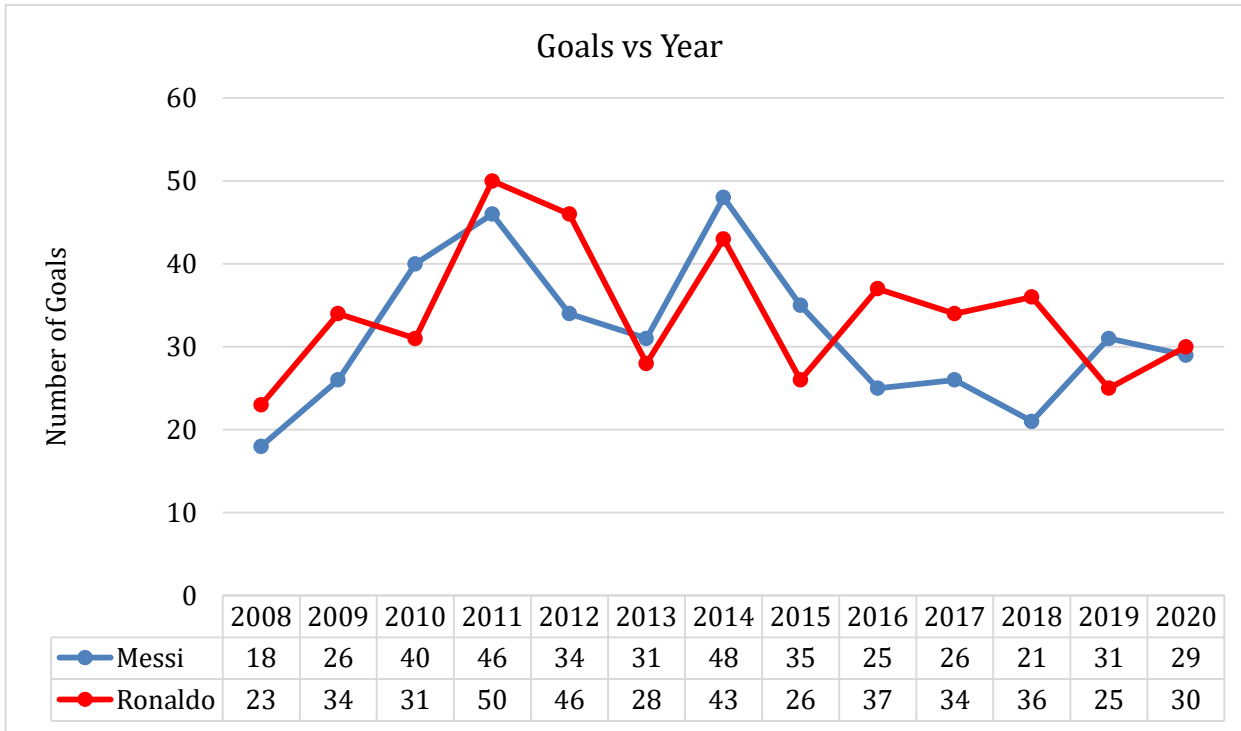

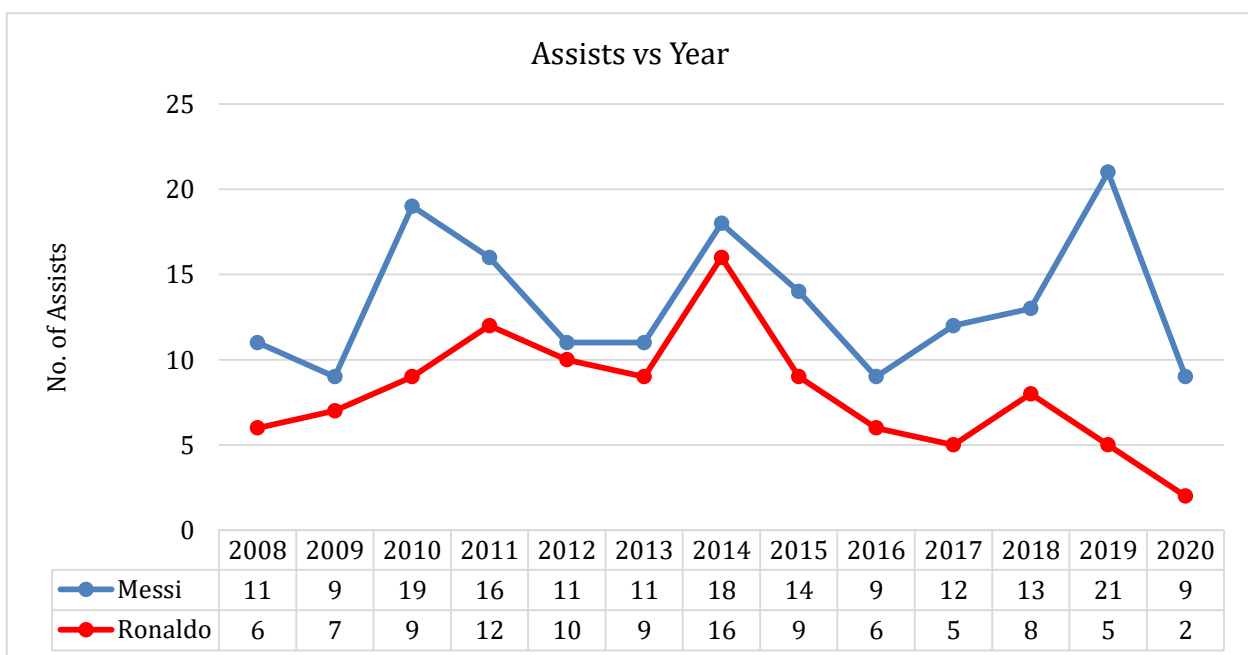

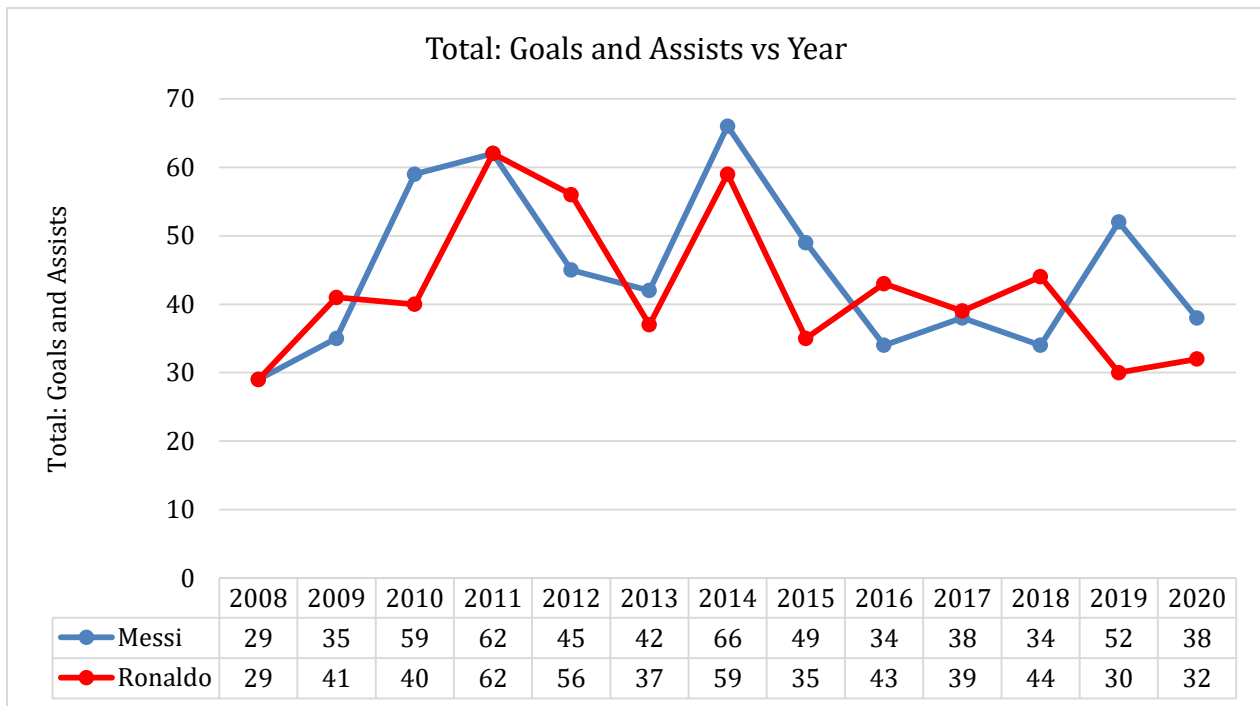
Graph 1: Goal vs Year for Messi and Ronaldo

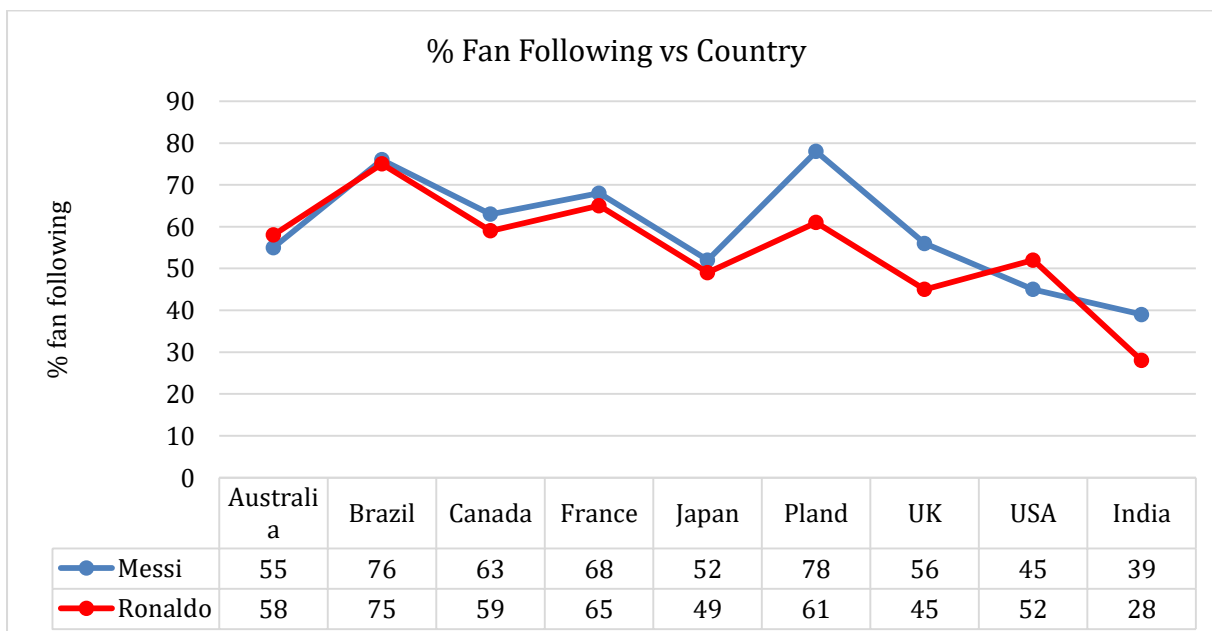
Graph 2: Assists vs Year for Messi and Ronaldo

3. Total: Goals and Assists



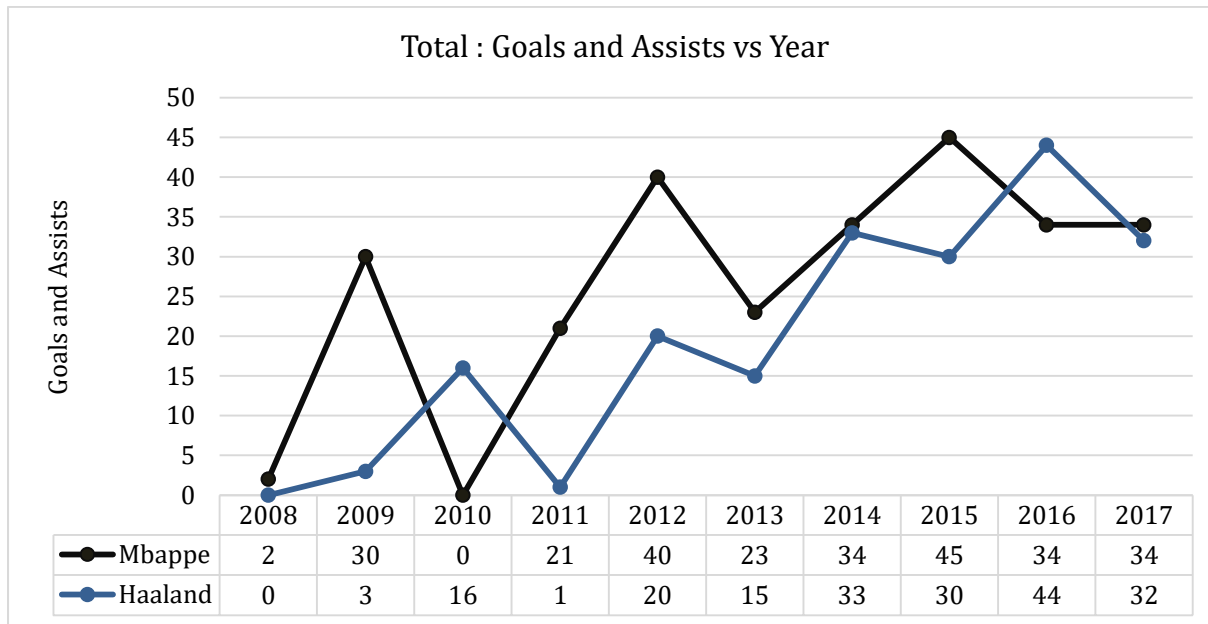
Graph 3: Total: Assists and goals vs Year for Messi and Ronaldo

Graph 5: Total: Assists and goals vs Year for Mbappe and Haaland

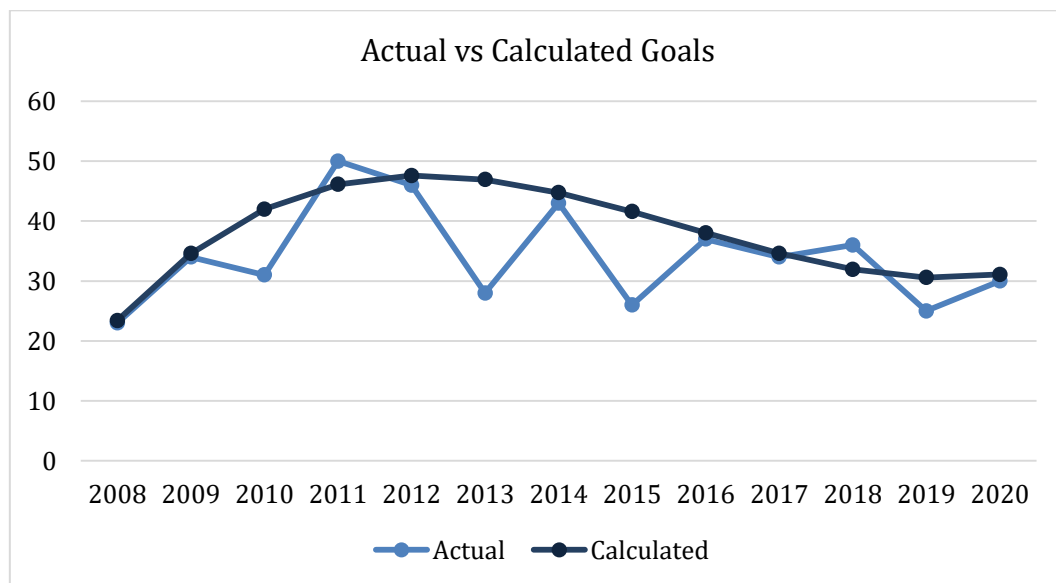

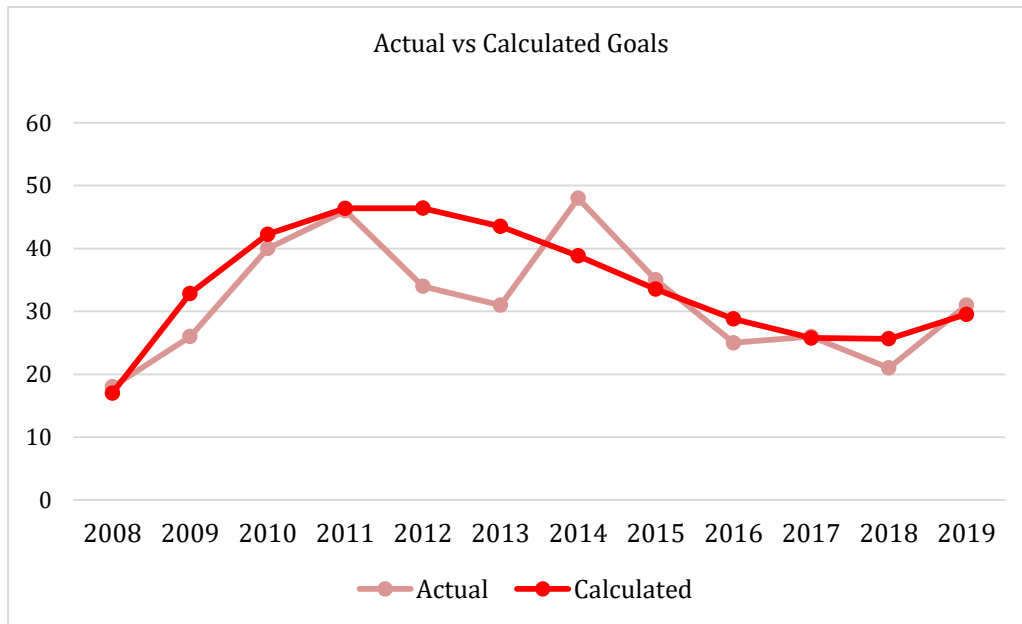

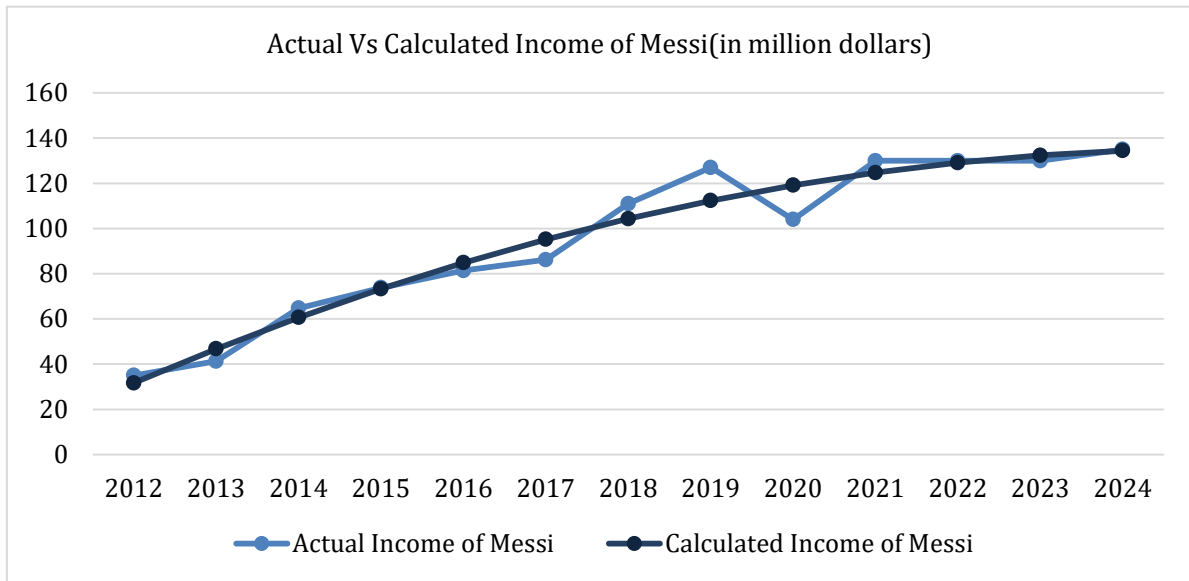

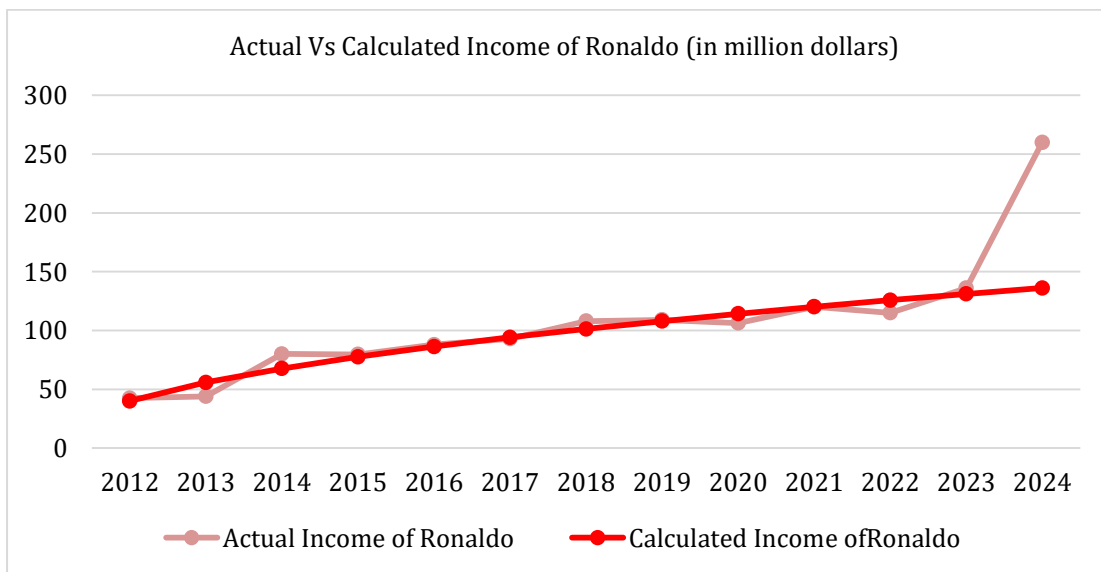
